Camp Morley, Clarks Beach, South of Auckland.

You will need to bring food for lunch and breakfast and any treats you want, and your own bedding, towels etc. You will need to provide your own transport.

**How about dialysis?**

No problem! CAPD is easy, and the Middlemore dialysis units will provide dialysis machines plus staff at the camp, but only from Monday to Thursday.
